

Online Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us at One2One Network. ("One2One", "we", or "us"). Our online privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") describes the types of information we gather from those persons visiting the Internet Web site www.one2onenetwork.com (the "Site") and how we use that information. **By accessing this Site, you agree to be bound by the Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not use this Site. Each time you use the Site, the current version of the Privacy Policy will apply. Accordingly, when you use the Site, you should check the date of this Policy (which appears at the top) and review any changes since the last version.**

1. Collection and Sharing of Information

We may collect two types of information from users of our Site: "personally identifiable information" (such as name, e-mail address, mailing address, phone number, birth date, etc.) and "aggregate information" (such as frequency of visits to the Site, Site pages most frequently accessed, IP address, browser type, marital status, household income, etc.)

We use this information in an effort to improve your experience on the Site and to communicate with you about various project directives. We may also use this information to make offers to you and to help us develop and improve our Site.

2. Collection of Personally Identifiable Information

We only collect personally identifiable information that is voluntarily provided by users of the Site when users register on the Site as a One2One Network Rep ("Network Rep(s)"). For example, when you register on the Site, you may be required provide personally identifiable information such as your name, e-mail address, mailing address, phone number, and birth date.

3. Collection of Aggregate information

We also collect aggregate information, which is non-personally identifiable/anonymous information, such as frequency of visits to the Site, Site pages most frequently accessed, IP address, browser type, marital status and household income. Aggregate Information is used in a collective manner, and no single person can be identified by that compiled information.

4. Sharing, Selling, and Trading Personally Identifiable Information Collected Online with Third Parties

We will not sell, share, trade or otherwise disclose personally identifiable information with third parties for their own marketing purposes. We may share personally identifiable information with third party service providers, such as shipping companies or companies who send e-mail communications on our behalf. These third parties are not authorized to retain, share, store or use your personally identifiable information for any purpose other than completion of the services for which they were hired.

In addition, in the following circumstances we may share or transfer personally identifiable information to unrelated third parties: (i) to comply with a legal requirement, judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on us; (ii) to investigate a possible crime, such as fraud or identity theft; (iii) in connection with the sale, purchase, merger, reorganization, liquidation or dissolution of our company; or (iv) when we believe it is appropriate to do so to protect the rights, property, or safety of our company or other persons.

5. Sharing, Selling and Trading Aggregate Information Collected Online With Third Parties

We may sell, share or trade compiled aggregate information with third parties. As stated earlier, no single person can be identified by such aggregate information.

6. Message Boards/Blogs

On the Site, we may provide message boards or blogs for Network Reps to post comments and messages for others to read along with areas for Network Reps to submit videos or photos. We may collect technical information about your post, such as the IP address from which you posted, and associate this information with your messages. Even if messages are deleted, we may retain copies and attendant information indefinitely.

When you post messages to the message boards or blogs or when you submit videos or photos to the Site, certain registration information, such as your email address, user name and/or full name, may be available to the public. Also note that any personal information you include in the body of your message or video/photo submission will be available to the public so it is important for you to exercise discretion and appropriate caution when deciding to reveal personally identifiable information in these areas.

7. Use of Cookies

Cookies are pieces of information which websites transfer to your computer's web browser for storage on your computer's hard drive. We use cookies to measure activity on our Site, which allows us to improve navigation throughout our Site. In addition, cookies on the Site may contain information (such as an unique user ID), which tracks the pages of the Site you have visited. This information allows us to make updates to enhance your experience. Parts of the Site will not function if you do not have cookies enabled. You can set your browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you turn off cookies or refuse them, though, you will not be able to use every portion of our Site.

8. Children and Privacy

We are concerned about the safety of children when they use the Internet, and understand that children may not understand all the provisions of our Privacy Policy or make informed decisions about the choices that are made available to adult users of the Site. We encourage parents and guardians to spend time with their children online and to be familiar with the sites their children visit. Our Site is not directed to children under the age of 13, and we will never request personally identifiable information from anyone whom we know to be under the age of 13 without verifiable parental consent.

9. Links to Other Websites

This Site may contain links to websites operated by other people or companies. Those websites may have their own privacy policy or no privacy policy at all. We do not have any responsibility for those websites, and we provide the links solely for the convenience of our visitors.

10. Security

The security of your personally identifiable information is important to us and we are committed to handling your information carefully. We restrict access to your personally identifiable information to employees who need to know that information in order to provide services. In addition, we make reasonable efforts to follow generally accepted industry standards to protect the personally identifiable information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, while we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personally identifiable information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
